1. General provisions

1.1. The Russian-Chinese Scientific Research Institute of Cross-Border Economics (hereinafter referred to as the TE Research Institute) is a structural unit of LONGMEI Educational Corporation LLC (hereinafter referred to as LONGMEI), which conducts fundamental and applied scientific research in order to develop science and practice of international trade and economic relations between Russia and China based on the organic interconnectedness of scientific, educational, cultural, informational and organizational activities.

1.2. The TE Research Institute was established by the decision of the President of the LUNMEI Educational Corporation (Order No. __ dated 11.10.2019), by the Editorial Board of the scientific multilingual multilingual electronic almanac "Cross-Border Economics", by the decision of Russia's leading scientists in the field of economic theory and Cross-Border economics and political processes as part of: • Doctor of Economics, Professor, Full Member of the Academy of Social Sciences Ostanin Vladimir Anatolyevich (Russia); • Doctor of Historical Sciences, Professor Pecheritsa Vladimir Fedorovich (Russia);.

1.3. The TE Research Institute is a separate structural subdivision of LONGMEI, guided in its activities by the laws of the Russian Federation and China in the field of scientific research, education, culture, other regulatory legal acts, the LONGMEI Charter, local regulations, and these Regulations.

1.4. Full name: Russian-Chinese Scientific Research Institute of Cross-Border Economics; in English: Russian-Chinese Research Institute for the Cross-Border

Economy. Abbreviated name: Research Institute of Technical Sciences (RC RI GbE).

1.5. The financing of the TE Research Institute is carried out through subsidies for financial support of planned research by the LONGMEI Educational Corporation, grants allocated by government authorities of Russia and China, sponsorship contributions from citizens of Russia and China, and other private organizations and institutions interested in the results of scientific research.

1.6. The activities of the TE Research Institute are coordinated by the scientific supervisor LONGMEI.

1.7. The direct scientific leadership of the TE Research Institute is carried out by the Director - scientific director of the TE Research Institute, who is appointed and dismissed by the order of the head of LUNMEI in the order of filling the positions of researchers.

1.8. The TE Research Institute includes the research centers of the LUNMEI Educational Corporation: • The Center for Research on the World Economy and International Economic Relations, • Center for Research on Global Finance and International Monetary, Credit and Financial Relations, • Center for Research on Cross-Border Economics, • Center for Research on Political, Social, Migration and Demographic Issues.

2. Goals and objectives

2.1. The main purpose of the TE Research Institute's activities is scientific research that forms the competitive position of the TE Research Institute in the field of fundamental and applied scientific developments that contribute to solving urgent problems of the Cross-border economy, deepening the socio-economic development of the Russian Federation and China, their effective integration into the modern global economy while realizing national interests, and developing economic cooperation with partner countries. members of international integration and other associations; preparation of proposals for the development of economic relations

with trade and economic associations, implementation of the results of fundamental and applied research in the educational process.

2.2. The main research directions of the TE Research Institute are:

2.2.1. patterns of development of the cross-border territories of Russia and China within the boundaries of the world economy in modern conditions and ongoing transformational processes, issues of globalization and regionalization, the formation of interstate principles of regulation of economic and legal relations within economic associations and organizations;

2.2.2. development of global, regional, interregional, and cross-border markets for goods and services. capital, labor, information products and services, including intellectual property rights;

2.2.3. development of global and national monetary and financial systems mediating international economic relations and regulated at the interstate, supranational and national levels;

2.2.4. assessment and examination of the reform of the Eurasian Economic Union, global and regional monetary systems, prospects for the development of global financial centers, and the financial and banking sector in a modern multipolar world, including a systematic analysis of international banking regulatory reform in terms of the interests of Russia and China;

2.2.5. the processes of economic migration, international experience of migration policy in attracting highly qualified personnel and specialists;

2.2.6. problems of sustainable development of the cross-border and global economies in the light of the existing challenges of global, regional and national economies, including issues of reducing income distribution disproportionality, creating conditions for the development of human capital, the role of demographic policy in shaping human potential;

2.2.7. risk analysis in international monetary, credit, and financial relations in Russia and methods of their insurance in world practice; new phenomena in the

relationship between market and government regulation of international monetary, credit, and financial relations.

2.3. The objectives of the TE Research Institute are:

2.3.1. development of the conceptual framework, methodology, theory, ideology and practice of international economic relations in the context of globalization and regionalization of the world economy and finance, international monetary, credit and financial relations in order to improve and develop the foreign economic policy of Russia and China;

2.3.2. participation in the development of scientific schools on world economy and world finance, including international monetary, credit and financial relations, on the economic foundations of a multipolar world;

2.3.3. implementation of fundamental and applied methodological and theoretical research in the field of international economic relations and foreign economic policy, methodological, consulting and expert–analytical activities for government authorities of the Russian Federation and China, interstate associations, commercial and non-profit organizations;

2.3.4. conducting fundamental research in the field of cross-border and global economics, finance, modern international economic relations, including monetary, credit, financial, as well as regional integration and non-integration associations;

2.3.5. active promotion of the integration of research and educational processes, effective implementation of the results of scientific research and development in the educational process;

2.3.6. implementation of scientific, methodological, theoretical, consulting, informational and expert-analytical support for the preparation and decision-making by management structures of various ranks on the problems of international economic relations, integration and non-integration regional economic associations.

2.3.7. provision of scientific, methodological, informational, analytical and consulting services in the field of international economic (foreign trade, its state and multilateral interstate regulation, movement of factors of production, including international cooperation and specialization), migration, socio-demographic

research, as well as financial, monetary, credit, banking relations for government authorities, municipalities, research and analytical centers, foundations, commercial organizations;

2.3.8. development and strengthening of scientific relations with scientific, research, analytical and educational centers of the Russian Federation, China, foreign countries, interstate regional associations and international organizations, with international scientific associations and societies;

2.3.9. the TE Research Institute's entry into the international, Russian and Chinese markets of fundamental and applied research, expert analytical developments and consulting services.

2.4. The main tasks of the TE Research Institute are:

2.4.1. scientific and methodological, theoretical, methodological, information and statistical, expert and analytical support for the preparation and adoption of conceptual, current and strategic decisions by state legislative and executive authorities in the field of formation of the main directions and implementation of state foreign economic policy, including the development of recommendations aimed at:

- a systematic analysis of the prospects for the development of globalization and regionalization of the cross-border and global economy, international integration processes, including industrial cooperation, geo-economic aspects of multipolarity, and theory and practice of foreign economic policy, including monetary, credit, financial, banking, and politics;

- Relations between the Russian Federation and China in the main areas of foreign economic policy in the context of modern challenges;

- study of the state and trends of the dynamics of social and ethnodemographic aspects of international economic relations in the context of globalization and regionalization of the world economy;

- conducting research aimed at increasing the international competitiveness and innovativeness of the Russian and Chinese economies in the context of the

development of modern international economic relations between Russia and China with foreign countries and regional associations;

- implementation of joint research with specialized departments of the Research Institute of Energy and Universities of China in the field of cross-border and global economies;

- execution of orders from interstate, federal and regional authorities in the core areas of the Research Institute of Energy;

- involvement of teachers, students, undergraduates, postgraduates and doctoral students of universities in Russia and China in the implementation of fundamental and applied scientific research at the TE Research Institute, followed by the defense of the obtained scientific results in the Dissertation Council of the TE Research Institute for the degrees of Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in Economics, Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) in politics.

3. Functions

3.1. In order to achieve the goals and objectives of the TE Research Institute, within the limits of its competence and in fulfillment of contractual obligations, LONGMEI performs the following functions.:

3.1.1. participates in the formation of the annual research plan of the Research Institute of Fuel and Energy and the preparation of accounting documentation based on the results of its implementation;

3.1.2. initiates, organizes and conducts scientific research on topics relevant to the TE Research Institute; participates in research on a contractual basis related to the competence of the TE Research Institute, together with the teaching staff of other Russian and Chinese universities within the framework of agreements reached;

3.1.3. carries out activities based on the current and long-term research plans of the Research Institute of Energy;

3.1.4. carries out analytical, expert, consulting and information and methodological activities, including at the request of public authorities;

3.1.5. forms, participates in and ensures the implementation of programs and projects, including within the framework of interuniversity and international cooperation;

3.1.6. organizes and conducts national and international scientific conferences, forums, symposiums, seminars, round tables and other scientific and public events based on the results of scientific, expert and other activities of the Research Institute of Energy;

3.1.7. prepares monographs, collections of scientific papers, analytical materials, textbooks, teaching aids and other scientific and educational developments based on the results of research conducted by the Research Institute of Energy;

3.1.8. promotes the expansion of the competence of researchers to activate publications in the scientific electronic almanac Cross-Border Economics, in leading Russian publications included in the Higher Attestation Commission and the RussianScience Citation Index (RSCI), foreign publications, as well as in publications included in international citation databases (Scopus, Web of Science, EconBiz, etc.);

4. Rights and responsibilities

4.1. The powers of the TE Research Institute to implement the goals, objectives and functions defined for it within the framework of the TE Research Institute's strategic planning are carried out in accordance with these Regulations.

4.2. The TE Research Institute, within its competence and within the framework of the functions assigned to it, has the right:

4.3. to submit for consideration by the head of the LONGMEI Educational Corporation proposals for improving their work and scientific research conducted by the TE Research Institute;

4.4. The LONGMEI Educational Corporation assigns office space, computing equipment, office equipment, communications equipment and other types of support to the Research Institute for the implementation of research and improvement of its

effectiveness. The TE Research Institute is responsible for the safety of the property assigned to it.

4.5. The rights, powers, duties, responsibilities, and qualification requirements of the staff of the TE Research Institute are determined by the laws of China, the Russian Federation, the internal regulations of the TE Research Institute and the relevant job descriptions.

5. Criteria for evaluating the activities of the TE Research Institute

5.1. Formal (scientometric) criteria based on the indexes of citation of scientific publications of a scientist according to the international database Scopus, Web of Science, EconBiz, Higher Attestation Commission by Research Institute researchers for articles over his entire scientific career, for articles published in the last 5 years; the Hirsch index.

5.2. Commercialization of scientific, expert and educational activities and their evaluation. It applies only to those scientific specialties in which commercialization is possible in principle, in other cases this section is not included in the set of assessments. For each specific creative group, the decision on the applicability of this criterion is made when it is approved in the structure of the Institute. These purposes are also served by patents obtained, contractual work with industrial and commercial (non-governmental) financing; contractual work with state financing.

5.3. Educational activities of employees. The Institute acquires the status of an educational organization in order to train highly qualified specialists in the programs Doctor of Philosophy in Economics, Doctor of Philosophy in Politics (PhD).

5.4. The structure of the Research Institute's educational activities. At the TE Research Institute, specialists are trained by an Educational Center with the inclusion of doctors of sciences assigned to each individual candidate for the degree of Doctor of Philosophy in Economics, Doctor of Philosophy in Politics (PhD).
